MINUTES SPECIAL HEARING

The Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Bertrand, Nebraska held a Special Hearing on September 10, 2024, immediately following the Budget Hearing, at the Village Hall by publishing in the Holdrege Daily Citizen on August 29, 2024, and posting at the First State Bank, Post Office, and Village Office. The agenda for said meeting was kept continuously at the office of the Village Clerk. Present were Chairman TJ Wilcox and Trustees Robert Dahlgren, Jason McNierney and Brian Schroeder. Also present were Village Utilities Superintendent, Matt Gregg; Village Clerk/Treasurer, Lori Vinzant; and Village Ordinance Officer, James Nelson. Trustee Lucas Evans absent.

The Chairman opened the Hearing at 6:55 PM and stated to all in attendance that a copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy posted in the room where the meeting was being held.

Village Clerk/Treasurer made a presentation of the final tax request for fiscal year 2024-2025. The property tax request for the General Fund is \$185,749.10 and the Bond Fund is \$176,750.00. The total assessed value of property differs from last year by 30.03%. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be 0.816798 per \$100 of assessed value. The operating budget will increase last year's budget by 6.84%.

The floor was then opened for public comment on the final tax request for fiscal year 2024-2025. Public comment ensued. All members of the public wishing to address the Board of Trustees were provided a reasonable amount of time to do so.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Schroeder, seconded by McNierney, to adjourn the budget hearing at 6:56 PM. Voting Aye, Schroeder, McNierney, Dahlgren, Wilcox. Evans absent.
